To the qualified electors of Jefferson County, Iowa:

Notice is hereby given that the combined City/ School Election will be held on Tuesday, November 2nd, 2021 from 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. at which time all qualified electors of the County of Jefferson, Iowa may cast votes.

Voters must vote in their precinct of residence. Please read this notice carefully to determine your correct voting location. Voting locations are the same as your regular presidential polling place. Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by 12:00 P.M. on Monday, November 8th, 2021. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
