

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS'
PROCEEDINGS
February 24, 2020**

At 9:31 A.M., Chair Hamilton called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Daryn Hamilton, Chairman; Dee Sandquist, Vice-Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Supervisor.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt that the minutes for the February 10th and 18th, 2020 meetings be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Motion was made by Dimmitt, seconded by Sandquist to table the proposed resolution to approve a speed limit change from 55 mph to 45 mph on Business 34 from Fairfield to a point 300' east of the Fairfield city limit line. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt to approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, it is desired to appropriate additional budget to Department 31 (District Court) in Service Area 1000 due to unusually high guardian ad litem expenses; and

WHEREAS, Department 28, Medical Examiner Service Area 1000 has ample budget;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County that a reappropriation of Service Area 1000 in the amount of \$5,000.00 from the Medical Examiner budget to the District Court budget be made.
