

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS’  
PROCEEDINGS  
February 1, 2021**

At 8:31 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Susie Drish, Vice-Chairman; Daryn Hamilton, Supervisor.

It was moved by Hamilton, seconded by Drish that the minutes for the January 18<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021 meetings be acknowledged. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Hamilton that the following resolution be approved:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Compensation Board meets annually to recommend a compensation schedule for elected officials for the fiscal year immediately following, in accordance with Iowa Code Chapters 331.905 and 331.907, and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Compensation Board met on December 15, 2020, and made the following salary recommendations for the following elected officials for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021:
