

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS’
PROCEEDINGS
March 3, 2021**

At 1:01 P.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Susie Drish, Vice-Chairman; Daryn Hamilton, Supervisor.

Supervisors received an employee request for closed session.
