

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS'**  
**PROCEEDINGS**  
**March 25, 2019**

At 9:00 A.M., Chair Dimmitt called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Lee Dimmitt, Chairman; Daryn Hamilton, Vice-Chairman; Dee Sandquist, Supervisor.

It was moved by Dee Sandquist, seconded by Daryn Hamilton that the minutes for the March 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019 meeting be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Dee Sandquist, seconded by Lee Dimmitt that the real estate taxes and fees which have been assessed against Timothy Goodell of Fairfield, Iowa, the parcel as follows:

are hereby suspended for the second half 2018 tax assessment due in March 2019. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Lee Dimmitt, seconded by Dee Sandquist that Jefferson County forfeit the Organ Donor Fund processing fee and give it all to the Organ Donor Fund. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Lee Dimmitt, seconded by Dee Sandquist that the disposal system contractor's license for Prosper Company be reinstated. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Dee Sandquist moved to table agenda item, human resource options.

Bruce Hudson, with RUSS gave an update on three nuisance properties. The first property was tabled. The second property will have until April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. RUSS will inspect on April 2, 2019. It was moved by Lee Dimmitt, seconded by Dee Sandquist to deny the extension. The third property's extension has expired and has been sent to the County Attorney office.

Sandquist reported on Pathfinders, Early Childhood, Childcare Steering Committee, department head meeting, SEIL and Public Health meeting. Hamilton reported on Semco, Southern Iowa Detention and Southern Iowa Development meeting. Dimmitt reported on the milestones meeting.
