ORDER FOR NOXIOUS WEED CONTROL ON COUNTY ROADS

Pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 317 the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors orders the eradication and control of the following noxious weeds growing within the right-of-way of all county roads: eradication of Palmer Amaranth and control of, Leafy Spurge, Canada Thistle, Bull Thistle, Teasel, Multiflora Rose, Field Bindweed, All other species of thistles belonging to the genus of Carduus and Water Hemp.

The noxious weeds shall be cut or otherwise destroyed within 15 days of this order. Any questions should be directed to Dan Miller, Weed Commissioner, in the Jefferson County Environmental Health Office, at 641-472-2561.
