

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS’  
PROCEEDINGS  
April 20, 2021**

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Susie Drish, Vice-Chairman; Daryn Hamilton, Supervisor.

It was moved by Hamilton, seconded by Drish that the Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County enter into closed session by reason of Iowa Code Section 21.5 (1)(j) “To discuss the purchase or sale of particular real estate only where premature disclosure could be reasonably expected to increase the price the governmental body would have to pay for that property or reduce the price the governmental body would receive for that property. The minutes and the audio recording of a session closed under this paragraph shall be available for public examination when the transaction discussed is completed.” Roll was then called: Hamilton "Aye".
