

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS’
PROCEEDINGS
May 3, 2021**

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Susie Drish, Vice-Chairman; Daryn Hamilton, Supervisor.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Hamilton that the minutes for the April 19th, 26th and 28th, 2021 meetings be acknowledged. All “Aye”. Motion carried.
