

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
October 18, 2021

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Susie Drish, Vice-Chairman; Daryn Hamilton, Supervisor.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Hamilton that the minutes for the October 12th, 2021 meeting be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Hamilton, seconded by Drish that the following resolution be approved:

MODEL FARM TO MARKET REVIEW BOARD APPLICATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a county may apply for modifications to its farm to market system to add or subtract mileage from its system, to accept or delete highways gained or lost through jurisdictional transfers, or to change the classification of roads within its system, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County has consulted with its County Engineer and desires to modify its farm to market road system to provide continuity of intra-county and inter-county routes, to meet the needs of existing or potential traffic, to better meet land use needs, or to provide a more suitable location for a farm to market route, and

WHEREAS, application for modifications to any county's farm to market system must be made to the Farm to Market Review Board per the requirements of Code of Iowa Section 306.6,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY that this county is formally requesting that the Farm to Market Review Board approve the following modifications to its farm to market system:

Road segments proposed for addition to the farm to market system:

(128th Street from Nipa Avenue to Nutmeg Avenue. (0.2 Miles) Nutmeg from 128th Street to 110th Street. (1.75 Miles))

Total Mileage added to the Farm to Market System: 1.95 miles

Road segments within city corporate limits as farm to market extensions:

NONE

Total Mileage added to Farm to Market Extension System: 0 miles

Road segments proposed for deletion from the farm to market system:

(128th Street from Nipa to Osage. (0.25 Miles) Osage Avenue from 128th Street to 122nd Street. (0.5 Miles) 122nd Street from Osage Avenue to Oak Avenue. (0.5 Miles) Oak Avenue from 122nd Street to 110th Street. (1.25 Miles)

Total Mileage deleted from the Farm to Market System: 2.5 miles

Road segments proposed for deletion from the farm to market extension system:

NONE

Total Mileage deleted from the farm to market extension system: 0 miles
