

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
February 14, 2022

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Hamilton called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Daryn Hamilton, Chairman; Susie Drish, Vice-Chairman.

Board member present via Zoom: Dee Sandquist, Supervisor.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Hamilton that the minutes for the February 7th and 9th, 2022 meetings be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer. It was moved by Hamilton, seconded by Drish to authorize DeWayne Heintz to spend up to \$65,000 for a tractor in an auction. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors met with Kevin Hatfield to discuss Pekin School Resource Officer.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to approve installation of a keypad lock on the employee breakroom door. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist that the compensation for Township Clerks and Trustees while engaged in official business be set at \$30.00 per meeting or an hourly rate of \$10.00 effective July 1, 2022. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors discussed the pop machine in the Courthouse basement.

Sandquist reported on her ISAC Supervisors' meeting. Hamilton reported on his 8th Judicial, RUSS and Assessor's Conference Board meetings. He also reported on his meeting to improve Zoom and his meeting regarding office space for the Public Defender's Office.

Public comments: Chris Estle reported the State will no longer be reporting Covid numbers.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Hamilton to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board discussed nuisance properties.

There being no further business, it was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to adjourn. All "Aye".
