

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
March 7, 2022

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Hamilton called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Daryn Hamilton, Chairman; Susie Drish, Vice-Chairman; Dee Sandquist, Supervisor.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish that the minutes for the February 28th, 2022 meeting be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist that the departmental re-appropriation resolution be postponed until March 21, 2022. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Hamilton, seconded by Drish that the Board of Supervisors chair and DeWayne Heintz be designated the Title VI Coordinators for Jefferson County. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to move ahead with the estimate for a new zoom system from ARP funds. All "Aye". Motion carried.

At 9:00 A.M., Sandquist moved, Drish seconded that the public hearing regarding the property tax dollar proposal be opened. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Chair Hamilton called for public comments. Public comments received were as follows: Aaron Kooiker asked what the General Basic and Rural Basic levy rates are.

Drish moved, Sandquist seconded to close the public hearing. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist that the following resolution be approved:

Approval of FY23 Maximum Property Tax Dollars

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors have considered the proposed FY23 county maximum property tax dollars for both General County Services and Rural County Services, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on county web site and/or social media accounts if applicable,

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was held on March 7, 2022,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County that the maximum property tax dollars for General County Services and Rural County Services for FY23 shall not exceed the following:

General County Services- \$5,602,527

Rural County Services- \$1,047,807

The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in either General County Services or Rural County Services for FY23 does not represent an increase of 102% from the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for FY22.

Motion was made by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to set the fiscal year 2023 public budget hearing for March 28, 2022 at 9:30 A.M. Motion carried.

Drish reported on her Safety meeting. Sandquist reported on her FEDA meeting. She also reported on the mediation with Fairfield City.

Public comments: Lee Dimmitt and Aaron Kooiker discussed the mediation with the City of Fairfield.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors discussed nuisance properties.

Pursuant to Sections 50.24 of the 2021 Code of Iowa, the Board of Supervisors meeting as a Board of Canvassers, publicly opened and canvassed the tally list of votes cast in the March 1, 2022 Special City Election for Fairfield as certified by the election board of the voting precincts and the absentee ballot counting board. The Official Canvass was completed on this date, March 7th, 2022. Upon completion of the canvass the County Commissioner of Elections will enter the votes in the Official Register.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to approve the election results as presented by Auditor's Office. All "Aye". Motion carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to adjourn. All "Aye".
Motion carried.
