

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS**  
**July 18, 2022**

At 8:31 A.M., Chair Hamilton called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Daryn Hamilton, Chairman; Susie Drish, Vice-Chairman; Dee Sandquist, Supervisor.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist that the minutes for the July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 meeting be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

Supervisors met with Annie Pollet from the SE Iowa Sierra Club to discuss an objection letter to the Iowa Utilities Board regarding the Navigator Pipeline.

At 9:00 A.M., Sandquist moved, Drish seconded that the public hearing regarding the Ordinance Amending Jefferson County Code of Ordinances (2010), Chapter 6-60 Regulating All-Terrain and Off-Road Utility Vehicles on Jefferson County Roadways be opened. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Chair Hamilton called for public comments. Public comments received were as follows: None.

Drish moved, Sandquist seconded to close the public hearing. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to pass the Ordinance Amending Jefferson County Code of Ordinances (2010), Chapter 6-60 Regulating All-Terrain and Off-Road Utility Vehicles on Jefferson County Roadways from the first reading to the second. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to set the second ATV/UTV Ordinance Public Hearing date and time for August 1, 2022 at 9:00 A.M. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors gave an update on ARPA.

Supervisors discussed the Walton Club delinquent taxes.

Sandquist reported on her SEIL Board meeting. Hamilton reported on his RUSS meeting and gave an update on County properties.

Public comments: Chris Estle gave a Public Health department update.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to adjourn. All "Aye". Motion carried.
