

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
August 22, 2022

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Hamilton called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Daryn Hamilton, Chairman; Susie Drish, Vice-Chairman; Dee Sandquist, Supervisor.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Hamilton that the minutes for the August 9th and 16th, 2022 meetings be acknowledged. Sandquist "Aye". Hamilton "Aye". Drish "Abstaining". Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

The Board met with property owners regarding a request for a 10-day extension to resolve the situation regarding trespass of livestock on a County road.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish that the Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County approve the pay increase of Darcy Wibstad, County Auditor's Accounting Clerk, to \$2,000.00 per pay period effective August 15, 2022. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors discussed uses of the opioid settlement money.

At 9:00 A.M., Sandquist moved, Drish seconded that the public hearing regarding the Ordinance Amending Jefferson County Code of Ordinances (2010), Chapter 6-60 Regulating All-Terrain and Off-Road Utility Vehicles on Jefferson County Roadways be opened. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Chair Hamilton called for public comments. Public comments received were as follows: Ralph Messerli stated that he thinks this is a good thing.

Sandquist moved, Drish seconded to close the public hearing. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to pass the Ordinance Amending Jefferson County Code of Ordinances (2010), Chapter 6-60 Regulating All-Terrain and Off-Road Utility Vehicles on Jefferson County Roadways from the second reading to the third on September 6, 2022 at 9:00 A.M. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Sandquist reported on her KMCD Spotlight Show interview and her SEIL meeting. Hamilton reported on his RUSS meeting.

Public comments: Lee Dimmitt suggested using the opioid settlement money for youth drug intervention.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to adjourn. All "Aye". Motion carried.
