

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
March 6, 2023

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Drish called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Susie Drish, Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Supervisor.

Board member present by Zoom was: Dee Sandquist, Vice-Chairman.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt that the minutes for the February 27th and March 2nd, 2023 meetings be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt, seconded by Drish to implement a reduction in speed on Glasgow for a distance to be determined by the County Sheriff, lengthening of the double yellow line, adding flashing lights, asking the County Engineer to contact Access Energy about relocating a utility pole and looking into vehicle activated lights. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt, seconded by Drish that the following resolution be approved:

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Dimmitt to approve the Safety Committee's recommended trainings. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Sandquist reported on the Ambulance Director job posting. Dimmitt reported on Jackson Point, his KMCD Spotlight Show interview and the Farm Show.

Public comments: Joe Ledger and Bart Richmond discussed options for the ambulance building.

It was moved by Dimmitt, seconded by Drish to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to adjourn. All "Aye". Motion carried.
