

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
May 15, 2023

At 8:31 A.M., Chair Drish called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Susie Drish, Chairman; Dee Sandquist, Vice-Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Supervisor.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt that the minutes for the May 8th, 9th, 10th and 12th, 2023 meetings be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt that the following resolution be approved:

FARM TO MARKET REVIEW BOARD APPLICATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a county may apply for modifications to its farm to market system to add or subtract mileage from its system, to accept or delete highways gained or lost through jurisdictional transfers, or to change the classification of roads within its system, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County has consulted with its County Engineer and desires to modify its farm to market road system to provide continuity of intra-county and inter-county routes, to meet the needs of existing or potential traffic, to better meet land use needs, or to provide a more suitable location for a farm to market route, and

WHEREAS, application for modifications to any county's farm to market system must be made to the Farm to Market Review Board per the requirements of Code of Iowa Section 306.6,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF Jefferson COUNTY that this county is formally requesting that the Farm to Market Review Board approve the following modifications to its farm to market system:

Road segments proposed for addition to the farm to market system: 218th Street (Old Highway 34) from the Henry County Line east approximately 1.6 miles to Route W40.

Total Mileage added to the Farm to Market System: 1.3 miles

Road segments within city corporate limits as farm to market extensions: This includes 0.3 miles on East Main Street in the City of Lockridge.

Total Mileage added to Farm to Market Extension System: 0.3 miles

Road segments proposed for deletion from the farm to market system: NONE

Total Mileage deleted from the Farm to Market System: _____ miles

Road segments proposed for deletion from the farm to market extension system: none

Total Mileage deleted from the farm to market extension system: _____ miles

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to approve the disposal system contractor's license for MG Services/ Marvin Aldrich. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors met with Brian Thomas.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt to approve the purchase of an ambulance. Sandquist amended the motion to add that the purchase would be contingent on the ambulance passing inspection. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt, seconded by Sandquist that Howard Garrison be appointed to the Veteran Affairs Commission effective July 1, 2023 for a term of 3 years. This term ends June 30, 2026. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to hire Kristin Burnstedt for the Park Technician/Ranger position with a starting annual salary of \$42,000. Her start day will be May 22, 2023. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Sandquist moved, seconded by Dimmitt to approve the hiring of Lauren Snyder and Nate Smithburg as seasonal employees (May-August) at a rate of \$13.00/her. Jon Pohren will continue to be Park Host for Mac Coon Access at \$400/month (April-October). All "Aye". Motion carried.

Sandquist reported on her ACT and SEIL meetings. Dimmitt reported on his meeting RUSS board meeting.

Public comments: John Morrissey spoke with the board about the need to abate property taxes for the City of Fairfield.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt to adjourn. All "Aye". Motion carried.
