

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
August 21, 2023

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Drish called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Susie Drish, Chairman; Dee Sandquist, Vice-Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Supervisor.

Public comments: None.

Supervisors met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish that the minutes for the August 15th and 16th, 2023 meetings be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to set the public hearing on the reclassification of Jefferson-Henry Road and 225th Street from Level B to Level C for September 5, 2023 at 9:00 A.M. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish that the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors approve the Liquor License for This Old Barn Venue LLC. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to appoint Theresa Tavera as Medical Examiner Investigator. Dimmitt suggested a friendly amendment contingent on approval from the Iowa Office of the State Medical Examiner. All "Aye". Motion carried.
