

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
November 20, 2023

At 8:17 A.M., Chair Drish called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Susie Drish, Chairman; Dee Sandquist, Vice-Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Supervisor.

Pursuant to Sections 50.24 of the 2023 Code of Iowa, the Board of Supervisors meeting as a Board of Canvassers, publicly canvassed the abstracts for the November 7, 2023 City/School Election for Fairfield school as certified by all participating counties. The Official Canvass was completed on this date, November 20th, 2023. Upon completion of the canvass the County Commissioner of Elections will enter the votes in the Official Register and issue certificates of election to the following successful candidates:

For Fairfield School Director At-Large:

Meghan Dowd Robbins, David Eastburn, Mark Thornton and Christie Kessel were elected.

For Fairfield School Director At-Large To Fill a Vacancy:

Deborah Williamson was elected.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to approve the canvass. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The abstract of votes and the canvass summary are hereby delivered to the Commissioner of Elections for the filing as required by law.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt that the minutes for the November 13th, 14th, and 17th, 2023 meetings be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.
