

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS**  
**March 18, 2024**

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Sanquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Vice-Chairman; Susie Drish, Supervisor.

Public comments: Bart Richmond gave an update on the Sheriff's office.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Dimmitt that the minutes for the March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2024 meeting be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Dimmitt to approve the Supplemental Agreement No. 3 for Design Services with Calhoun-Burns & Associates, Inc. for increased survey expense for design of Libertyville Road Bridge Project: BRS-C051(72)—60-51 and authorize the chair to sign. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Dimmitt that the following resolution be approved:

**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS: The Jefferson County board of Supervisors is empowered under the authority of the code of Iowa, Section 321.236 sub(8), 321.471 to 321.473 to prohibit the operation of vehicles or to impose limitations as to the weight thereof on designated highway structures under their jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS: The Jefferson County Engineer has had the following bridges inspected and determined that restrictions should be designated based on present structural conditions.

BE IT RESOLVED: to adopt for Jefferson County, new load post ratings for 2024 as proposed by Calhoun Burns and Associates yearly 2024 Bridge Report, to use as the legal weight and load limits for the following structures in Jefferson County:

FHWA Structure # 201451 – New Structure(Flat Car) Post "40 Tons"

FHWA Structure # 202220 – Low Water Stream Crossing (LWSC)

FHWA Structure # 201380 –Change Posting from "28,40,40 Tons" to "20, 33, 37 Tons"

FHWA Structure # 201590 – Post "20, 30, 30 Tons"

FHWA Structure # 201790 – Post "20, 33, 34 Tons"

FHWA Structure # 200480 – Change Posting from “10 Ton” to “6 Tons” and keep “One Lane”  
FHWA Structure # 201860 – Change Posting from “15, 24, 24 Tons” to “6 Tons”  
FHWA Structure # 202050 – Post “24, 36, 39 Tons” and “ All Vehicles”
