

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
April 8, 2024

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Sanquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Vice-Chairman; Susie Drish, Supervisor.

Public comments: None.

It was moved by Dimmitt, seconded by Drish that the minutes for the April 1st, 2024 meeting be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Dimmitt, seconded by Drish to approve submittal to the Iowa Department of Transportation of the Secondary Roads Department fiscal year 2025 budget. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt, seconded by Drish to approve submittal to the Iowa Department of Transportation of the Secondary Roads Department current Five-Year Construction Plan 2025-2029. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors met with the Ambulance Director.

Supervisors met with Ed Malloy for an update on Grow Fairfield.

Motion was made by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt to set the fiscal year 2025 public budget hearing for April 29, 2024 at 9:00 A.M. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Motion was made by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to set the meeting date for declaring emergency medical services to be an essential service for June 17, 2024. All "Aye". Motion carried.

At 9:00 A.M., it was moved by Drish, seconded by Dimmitt that the public hearing to rescind the reclassification of a portion of 110th Street be opened. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF SERVICE “B” ROADS

WHEREAS, Jefferson County desires to classify certain roads on the area service system in the County to provide for a minimal level of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Jefferson County, after consultation with the County Engineer, has the authority to specify certain roads within the County as Area Service “B” roads pursuant to Iowa Code Section 309.57; and

WHEREAS, The Jefferson County Board of Supervisors after consulting with the Jefferson County Engineer, desire to designate various roads in Jefferson County on the Area Service “B” System to provide for a reduced level of maintenance in order to best utilize maintenance funds, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Notice of Public Hearing duly published according to the Iowa Code, Public Hearing as held on the 8th day of April, 2024 at 9:00 A.M. in the Board of Supervisors room at the Jefferson County courthouse, Fairfield, Iowa, to hear support and or objections from the public on roads so designated.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY that this County does hereby establish the roads described as an Area Service “B” road, with restricted access and a minimal level of maintenance.

Road Description: 110th St (FROM W21 to City Lagoon). IN SEC.12 of PENN TOWNSHIP FROM CLASS “A” TO A CLASS “B” ROAD.
