

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS
May 13, 2024

At 8:30 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Vice-Chairman; Susie Drish, Supervisor.

Motion was made by Dimmitt, seconded by Drish to set the public hearing on the resolution vacating Fleener St in Abingdon from Cedar Ave to the Delbert and Mary Ann Nordyke property line for May 28, 2024 at 9:30 A.M. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Motion was made by Sandquist, seconded by Dimmitt to set the public hearing on vacating an alley and conveying it to the adjacent property owners in East Pleasant Plain for May 28, 2024 at 9:40 A.M. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors met with the Interim Ambulance Director.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Sandquist to approve the new Ambulance Director job description as written. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt, seconded by Sandquist to post the new Ambulance Director job until June 7, 2024 at 4:00 P.M. with resumes to go to Dee Sandquist. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Drish moved, seconded by Dimmitt to approve the hiring of Lauren Snyder as a seasonal (mid-May through mid-August) County Conservation Naturalist intern at a rate of \$15.00/hr. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors met with Mendy McAdams from the Chamber of Commerce about the establishment of Main Street Fairfield.

It was moved by Drish, seconded by Dimmitt that Paul Corbin be appointed to the Veteran Affairs Commission effective July 1, 2024, for a term of 3 years. This term ends June 30, 2027. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Joan Salts updated the Board on the Bonnifield Cabin.

It was moved by Sandquist, seconded by Drish to put a fundraising sign for the Bonnifield Cabin projects on the west side of the Courthouse property, north of the driveway. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Dimmitt reported on his McElhinney house and RUSS meetings. Sandquist reported on her Mental Health Agency of Southeast Iowa meeting. She also reported on her ICAP call and the Maple Street building clean out.

It was moved by Dimmitt, seconded by Sandquist to allow the claims against the county in the amount of \$61,767.14 and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.
